I have nothing to offer but commitment and creativities.

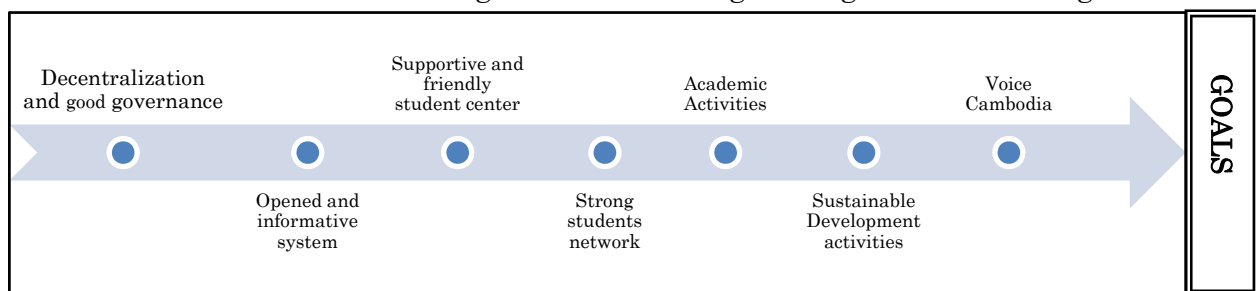
If I am elected, the followings are my priority concerns.

- ⊕ Maintain and upgrade the information system

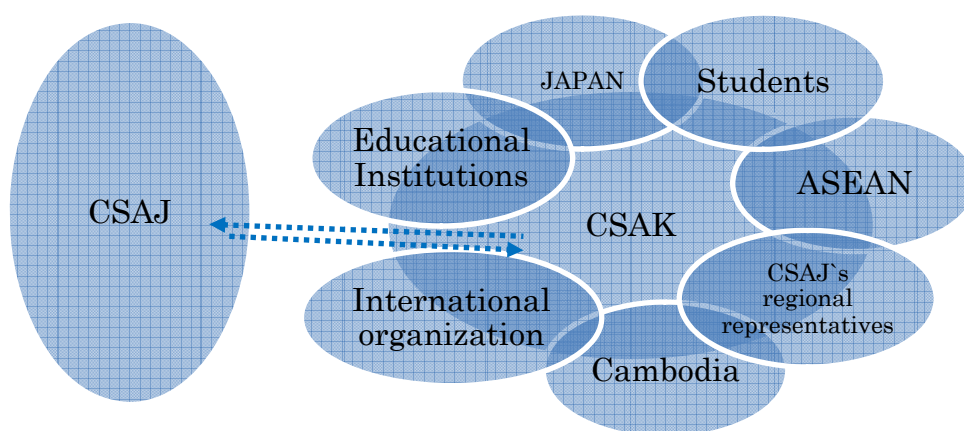
iii. Supportive and friendly student center
