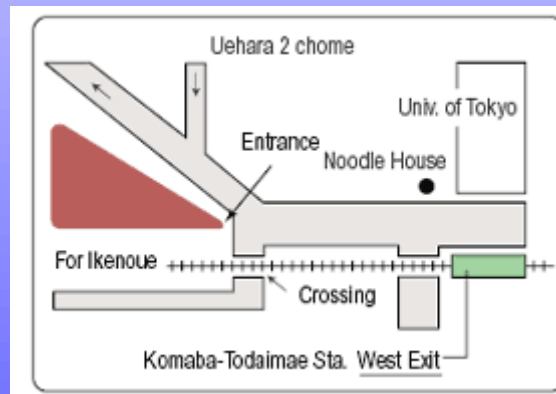
American Assistance for Cambodia (AAfC)/Japan Relief for Cambodia(JRfC) is a nonprofit organization recognized by the Kingdom of Cambodia.

It has helped to construct more than 400 primary and lower secondary schools in rural Cambodia, equipped with solar panels, computers, Internet-access, English teachers, vegetable gardens, bookshelves of books, and nurses.

In 1997, AAfC/JRfC built the charity **Sihanouk Hospital – Center of Hope**, which provides free outpatient treatment for 300 patients a day and has two wards for hospitalized patients.

As the vice chairman of AAfC/JRfC, **Ms. Debbie Krisher-Steelie** has been to Cambodia numerous times and know about Cambodia quite well.
